

Here is a detailed list of the materials needed for oil painting. This selection ensures that you are well equipped to work creatively and realise your artistic visions.

1. Stretcher frames:

Strips + crossbars (connecting pieces)

Choose the desired size of your stretcher frame. Small and medium formats up to 80 x 110 cm are recommended.

2. Painting mediums Quick-drying painting mediums

We recommend products from "Schminke" or "Pigmente Kremer". These mediums promote rapid drying and allow you to complete several steps in a single day.

3. Oil base colours

To achieve a wide range of colours, you will need the following basic colours:

- Titanium white
- Cadmium red or vermilion
- Cadmium yellow
- Prussian blue
- Cadmium orange
- Burnt umber
- Ivory black
- Chromium oxide green

4. Colour backgrounds

Acrylic paints are suitable for applying colour backgrounds, ideally in the same shades as the oil paints to create a harmonious base. (Basic colours as in point 3)

5. Additional materials

Rabbit glue and gesso primer Stapler
and staples Cotton fabric

I provide these materials for a fee, depending on your personal consumption.

5. Brush

- 2 small round fine-hair brushes for working out small details and for corrections (thickness 3-6)
- 2 medium flat fine hair brushes (size 7-10)
- 2 medium round bristle brushes (size 7-10)
- 2 wide bristle brushes. Flat with rounded tips, for large formats (thickness 12-18) Possibly 1 painting knife (depending on the situation, for applying paint (painting knife with flexible handle)
or mix paint (palette knife)

6. Tools

- Metal spatula: For mixing the colours
- Palette or glass plate: acrylic glass, slightly thicker
- Painting smock or work clothes
- Disposable gloves: One size larger than the user's hands

7. Cleaning and care

- Brush cleaner and a bar of curd soap
- Glass jar (jam jar with screw cap): For cleaning brushes
- Rags
- One to two rolls of kitchen paper

This list provides you with a solid foundation for getting started with oil painting. Make sure you have all the materials you need before you start so that you can focus on being creative. Have fun painting!
