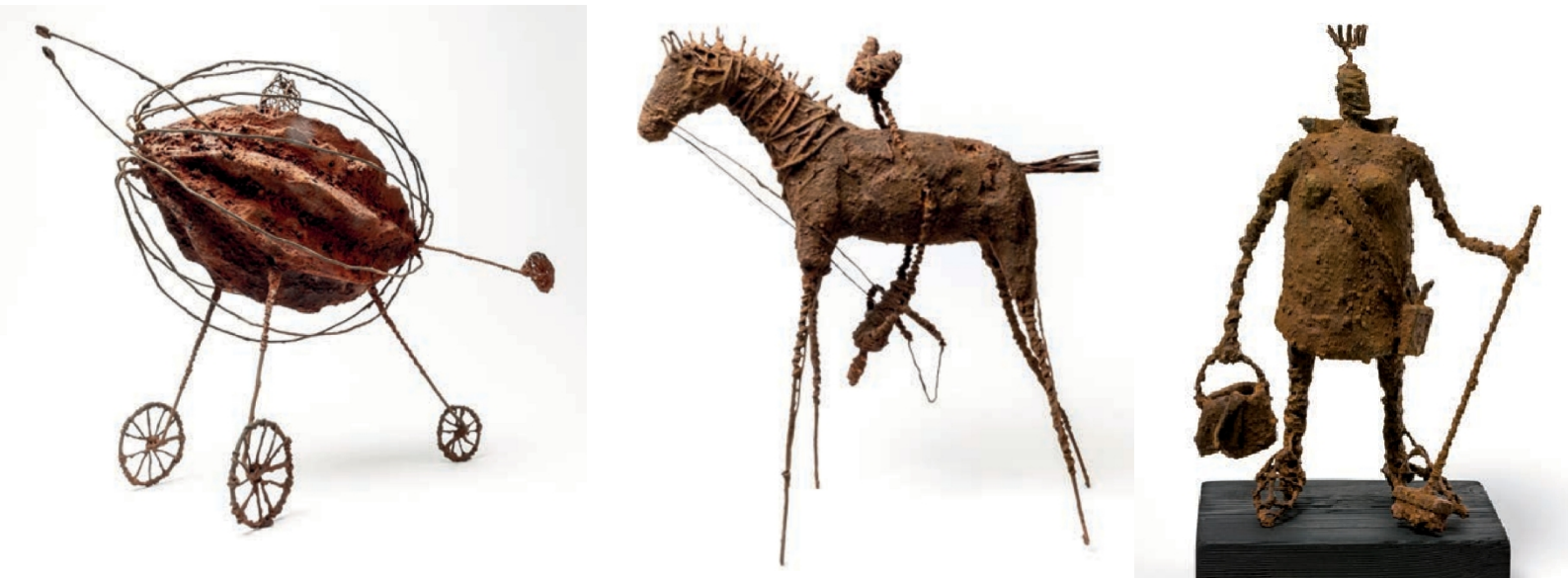


Rust Sculpture Workshop | Franz Seidl



TOOLS AND MATERIALS

The course instructor will provide the necessary tools. However, there are a few items that you should bring with you if possible. (Don't worry if you don't have everything; I have spares...)

PLEASE BRING:

- Sturdy (leather) gardening gloves that fit well
- Cheap bristle brushes: flat brushes approx. 4-5 cm wide and 2.5-3 cm, possibly an additional 5-6 mm; the cheapest set from the hardware store or discount store will do!
- Safety goggles: yes, really!
- 1-2 pickle jars with screw caps
- 1-2 flat plastic containers with lids: 1-liter ice cream containers are ideal
- Sketching materials (paper, pencil, eraser)
- Work clothes ()

IF AVAILABLE, please bring:

- Coarse wood rasp
- Thick marker pen for sketching on Styrodur
- Old hair dryer (which may get dirty) or hot air gun
- Hot glue gun + glue stick refills (11mm)
- "Found objects": old rusty nails, small pieces of driftwood, etc. can sometimes be nicely integrated. But this is not essential! (Larger pieces of iron cannot be used as we do not weld!)
- Stanley knife (cutter with large snap-off blade, with metal blade guide)
- 1-2 large plastic garbage bags (120 L)
- Extension cord/power strip, if necessary

Please mark your own tools to avoid confusion!

MATERIALS:

All construction materials for the objects will be provided by the course instructor and are available for a **flat fee of €45**; please pay in cash on site. The flat fee does not include the rust patina chemicals, which will be charged according to actual consumption (costs usually range from approx. €30 to €50, depending on the size of the object). (The bases required for some objects are also not included; advice on options will be provided during the course.)
