Please feel free to bring as much of the materials you want to experiment with as you like. Mr. Awe recommends, for example: Papers and canvases: - various formats in your preferred size - paper recommendation: pad A1/A2 drawing paper, pad of watercolor paper size 40x30 (more/larger depending on your experiment) - Canvases: small format 60x60 as well as other medium to large formats (maximum 180x180cm) - It is possible to assemble the frames on site, if desired under the guidance of the artist. Colors: - Any kind of water-based paint is welcome - please bring your selection of acrylic, ink and watercolor paints - as well as wax oil pastels and a selection of spray cans (e.g. Belton, Sparvar or even DIY store paints) Other materials: - Brushes - Pencils, Edding, marker - adhesive tapes in different sizes and easily removable like masking tape - foils for cutting stencils, scissors and cutters - stencils of all kinds for spraying through, the more ornamental the better - empty cups / containers for mixing paint - painting clothes - unusual Unusual painting utensils of all kinds, such as feathers, straws, squeegees, rakes, forks, combs, toothbrushes, printing rollers, ornamental rollers, brushwood bundles, shaving brushes, brushes, wax, marbles. The artist will bring and provide an initial starter set for you to try out. Please bring your own work in progress to continue painting and also finished work samples in the original or photographs as a basis for discussion.
