Please bring: 1.) for working

- work clothes for dirty work
- a hair dryer and/or hair dryer to dry the work when the weather is bad!
- old papers with character, such as sheet music, book pages, handmade paper, Japanese paper...

To bring: 2.) for molding:

- old shoes for molding
- old shirts, pants, undershirts, sheets or duvet covers, T-shirts made of natural fibers such as cotton, linen, hemp...
