

MATERIAL LIST

- Pencils in different sizes (from 8B - soft to 4H - hard)
- Graphite pencils, different degrees of hardness, not water-soluble!!!
- Graphite blocks, thick graphite pencils, not water-soluble!!!
- Erasers, kneadable erasers, several types
- Drawing pad or loose sheets up to DIN A2 or 100x70cm, white, at least 180 g/m², better 200 g/m², no thicker than 220 g/m²
- A few, older, simple bristle brushes (soft, hard, wide, very wide, medium-sized narrow)
- graphite powder (small, round plastic container) and aromatic-free turpentine 2 liters "Tauro", available from Boesner or from artists' supply stores
- empty pickle jars with a wider opening
- paper clips (paper fastening) or masking tape
- cotton rags (e.g. old T-shirts)
- cutter knife
